**Admission requirements:**

1. An original and three copy of the Bachelor degree and/or the recently obtained degree
2. Three copies of the Accreditation certificate issued by the Supreme Council of Universities for non-Egyptians and private universities
3. An original transcript and three copies of the 4years of the BA and/or the recently obtained degree
4. Two recommendation letters
5. An original and three copy of Birth certificate
6. Three copies of the ID card or passport
7. Six recent personal photos (six months old)
8. Three copies of the military certificate when applicable
