2. Helm orders.
3. Change-over from automatic pilot to hand steering and vice versa
4. Responsibilities of a look-out, including reporting the approximate bearing of a sound signal light or other object in degrees or points.
5. Shipboard terms and definitions.
6. Use of appropriate internal communication and alarm systems.
7. Ability to understand orders and to communicate with the officer of the watch on matters relevant to watch keeping duties.
8. Procedures for the relief, maintenance and handover of a watch.
9. Information required to maintain a safe watch.
10. Basic environmental protection procedures.
11. Knowledge of emergency duties and alarm signals.
12. Knowledge of pyrotechnic distress signals; satellite EPIRBs and SARTs.
13. Avoidance of false distress alerts and action to be taken in event of accidental activation.
